Often you can also visit the changing rooms. We conclude in the stadium museum, a place full of football paraphernalia with trophies, cups, shirts and more.

Pantheon The Pantheon is a masterpiece of architecture with its huge hemispherical dome. It also contains the tombs of the kings of Italy and that of the artist, Raphael.

Trevi Fountain Toss a coin in the Trevi Fountain, traditionally believed to ensure a safe return to the Eternal City.

Piazza Navona Full of life and highlighted by one of Rome's most spectacular fountains, the Four Rivers designed by Bernini.
